

## **Description of the machine**

1.10

#### Correct use of the machine

1.10.1

The machine must be used only to cut the media which it has been designed for (FOAM - SEMI-FOAM PVC) see table of media paragraph 3.3.1.

The machine is made of physically independent and autonomous groups, therefore the proper use of the machine also refers to the correct functioning of only one part of it.

#### Use of the machine

The installation and the maintenance of the machine must be carried out by qualified personnel only.

The machine was designed to be used in an area with the following characteristics:

- Protection from atmospherics.
- Proper illumination.
- Temperatures between 18° C and 35° C
- Amount of humidity from: from 30 % to 80 %.
- Power supply, optional LASER tracer, with the following characteristics:
  - Voltage and single-phase frequency:

230V/240V 50Hz - (110V/60Hz).

- Absorption:

max. 0.2A - (max. 0.5A).

#### Incorrect use of the machine

1.10.2

Any use other than that indicated in part 1.11.1 Correct use of the machine is to be considered incorrect, especially:

- Using the machine in ways which differ from those which it has been designed for, represents an anomalous condition and could therefore damage the structure of the machine.
- Using the machine without its protections and without the safety equipment it is provided with: particularly without the fixed protections that block access to the internal equipment.







## **Transportation**

4.2

#### **Transportation conditions**

4.2.1

The trimmer is shipped with a packaging including carton sheets 1 a to protect the panels and the top ends of the machines, and everything is then placed inside a carton box 2. *Fig. 4.1 Transportation conditions*.




Use only proper lifting means and accessories that comply with the laws in force.

Please take the necessary precautions to avoid any crashes and overturning. Protect the machine from external atmospherics.





## Assessment of damages during transportation

4.2.2

Check the conditions of the machine by visually inspecting it, after having removed it from the shipping box. Any defects on the visible parts of the machine indicate crashes during transportation, which could also affect the normal operation of the machine.

Especially assess the conditions of these parts:

Carriage Plexiglas shield.

Make sure the screws and nuts are tightly fixed, particularly the screws on the carriage handle, the blade holder and the carriage itself.



Assembly 4.3

#### Assembly of table and fixing the trimmer


4.3.1


- Open the packaging box 2 which contains all parts (Fig. 4.1 Transportation conditions).
- Remove carton protection 1.

This operation must be carried out by at least four people.

- Remove the trimmer and position it on a flat surface.
- Remove the parts needed to assemble the table:
  - ◊ Two shoulders
  - ♦ Two cross bars, one top and one bottom (The top cross bar differs from the bottom one for the holes with threaded bush, placed on one side).
  - ♦ Shelves to level out the work table.
  - ♦ Bag with the screws and whatever needed to assemble the table.
- Screw on the lower cross bar, first one shoulder and then the other 1.
- Screw the shelves on the top cross bar 2. Screw on the thickness on the end of the shelves to level out the table 3-4.
- Screw the top cross bar to the shoulder, with the shelves used to level out the work table facing upward. **5**.
- Position the trimmer on top of the assembled table and fix it to the table by using the supplied screws. **6**.
















## Adjustment of work table

4.3.2

- Position a blade in the blade holder and fix it to the carriage, see chapter 4.3.3 BLADE ASSEMBLY
- Trim a foam sheet about 2 mt. long.
- Position the trimmed foam sheet on the trimmer table.
- Verify that the table and the foam sheet are parallel as follows:
- Adjust the pins under the table, by acting on nut **7**, until you reach the desired level of parallelism.






## **Assembly of blade**

4.3.3



Wear protection gloves while assembling the blades because they are very sharp.

- Completely close the sheet holder 8.
- Completely lower the blade guide 9-10, turning the knob A.
- Remove the three screws that fix the blade holder carriage cover 11.
- Assemble the blade by introducing it first in the blade guide and then on the pin fixed on the carriage. **12**.
- Lift the key and push the blade introducing it into the blade holder slot 13.
- Use a screwdriver to bring the return spring over the profile of the blade. 14.
- Screw the blade holder carriage back on. 15.
- Make sure the Plexiglas shield is tightly fastened on the blade guide profile. 16.





• The trimmer is now ready to start its operating phase.

No other adjustments are necessary because the machine is factory tested..

Storage 4.4

The indications contained in this section must be followed during the periods of temporary storage of the machine which could take place in the following situations:

- When the machine is not installed immediately after it is delivered.
- When the machine is disconnected and stored while waiting for it to be relocated.

Characteristics 4.4.1

- Temperature between: 5°C and 35°C
- Humidity: from 30 % to 80 %.
- Proper natural and/or artificial illumination.
- · Proper protection from atmospherics.
- Adequate space to carry out the lifting and transportation operations in a safe and easy way.
- Horizontal surface with a capacity higher than the mass of the machine.
- Adequate space to carry out ordinary maintenance and technical operations



# Placing of the machine

4.5

#### Characteristics of the area the machine is placed in

4.5.1

#### Optional LASER module power supply

The area where the machine is installed must be equipped with the power supply connections described in 3.2 Power supply data.

#### Space requirements

For the normal use of the machine and the loading and unloading operations, it is important to have an area directly proportional to the size of the media to cut.

#### Protection from atmospherics

The machine must be placed in a suitably protected room, away from atmospherics.

#### Floor requirements

Prepare the stable horizontal surface of the machine keeping in mind the mass of the machine itself. Also take into account all extra accessories.




Optimal stability and using conditions can be obtained with a maximum planarity error of ± ... mm/m.

#### Illumination

A good illumination is necessary to safely use and carry out maintenance operations (approximately 200 - 600 lux).

#### Atmospheric characteristics of the area

- Temperature: from 18°C to 35°C.
- Humidity: from 30 % to 80 %.

# **Qualifications of the operator**

5.1

The machine must be used by qualified personnel only.

Place of work 5.1.1

Position of the operator: during the start up and cutting operations in front of the machine with control panel in the center. During maintenance operations the position depends on the specific operation that needs to be carried out.



# Feeding the media to cut


5.2

Follow the steps below to begin the process:

Before starting any cutting operations we suggest checking the height of the balde guide. It must be right for the thickness of the media to cut. This will prevent low or hight cuts and will prevent the carriage from blocking itself against the panel to trim.

#### Cut soft media (ex. FOAM) in the following way:


- Bring the carriage against the right shoulder of the machine.
- Open the sheet holder by turning the handwheel on the left side of the machine 1.
- Position the panel on the work table **A**. Close the sheet holder by using the handwheel used to open it **2**.
- Remove the front knob of the carriage **B**, and adjust the height of the blade guide according to the thickness of the material to trim **3**, by using the left knob **C**. After adjusting the height of the blade guide block it by using the front knob **B**.
- Adjust the cutting blade **4**, by using the right knob **E**, so that it slides into the relevant slot on the work table.
- Cut the media by pulling or pushing the carriage from right to left 5-6.



Lift the sheet holder bar and remove both trimmed parts from the work table.



- Cut hard medium ( ex. PVC SEMIESPANSO ) in the following way:
  - Bring the carriage against the right shoulder of the machine.
  - Open the sheet holder by turning the handwheel on the left side of the machine 7.
  - Position the panel on the work table **A**. Close the sheet holder by using the handwheel used to open it **8**.
  - Remove the front knob of the carriage **B**, and adjust the height of the blade guide according to the thickness of the material to trim **9**, by using the left knob **C**. After adjusting the height of the blade guide block it by using the front knob **B**.
  - Adjust the cutting blade by using the right knob **E**, until the blades is in the position indicated in the illustration **10**, at about **0.5 mm** from the feeding table.
  - Start the first cutting phase, by pulling or pushing the carriage from right to left 11 Make the final cut, by pulling or pushing the carriage from left to right. 13.



• Lift the sheet holder bar and remove both trimmed parts from the work table.





## Characteristics of the media to cut

5.2.1

This trimmer was designed to cut "FOAM" and SEMI-FOAM PVC (see table of media paragraph 3.3.1).

We recommend not trying to cut materials different form those which the machine has be	ee
designed for. They could seriously damage the machine.	



# **Ordinary maintenance**

6.1



Untimely movements during maintenance operations. Be very careful.



Risk of electric shocks and untimely movements during maintenance. Isolate the machine from power supply sources by unplugging the power cable of the LASER tracer (optional).

Ordinary maintenance includes all those periodical and preventive operations that allow the machine to be used safely.

#### **Qualifications of the operator**

6.1.1

Ordinary maintenance of the machine must be carried out by qualified personnel only.

6.1.2

# **Qualifications of the operator**

7.1

The machine can be demolished by qualified personnel only.

## **Deactivation of the machine**

7.2

Once the machine has reached the end of its technical and operating life, it must be deactivated. The machine must be deactivated and put in the condition of not being used for the purposes which it had originally been designed for. However, it must allow the reuse of the raw materials which it was built with.

#### **Procedures**

7.2.1

- Disconnect the power cable of the optional LASER tracer if installed.
- In case the machine has to be moved, refer to 4.2 Transportation.

Procedure A.1

Open the box containing the assembly kit of the optional LASER tracer


- Make sure nothing is missing from the box.
- 1. Screw the laser emitter holder bracket **1** on the same shoulder.
- 2. Screw the laser emitter to the previous bracket.



- 3. Slide the power cable **2** in the hole on the work table from the bottom upwards. Lock the cable with the relevant cable clamp. **3**.
- 4. Position the ON/OFF LASER switch 4 in the slot on the closure sheet.










# OF LASER TRACER optional



- 5. Connect the small faston of the power cable and the small faston of the laser emitter to the switch
- 6. Connect the remaining connectors.
- 7. Connect the feeder to a power outlet.
- 8. Make sure the light of the laser beam is directed along the cutting line on the work table. If necessary adjust the bracket until it is lined up correctly with the cutting line.
- 9. Then fasten the cover to the shoulder **5-6**.





## **Electric wiring of optional LASER tracer**

A.1.1



Make sure the electric line has the appropriate wattage requirements to power the machine.




Electric risks. Make all ground connections before any other connections to the mains.

- Section the electric line that powers the machine.
- If the sectioning device is the mains plug, the power outlet must be easily accessible and near the machine.
- Switch on the electric line that powers the machine.


## Use of LASER tracer for the cut

A.1.2

The laser tracer is mainly used when you need to precisely trim panels which already have squaring marks on them.

Follow this procedure to use the tracer:

- Switch on the laser tracer 7
- Start cutting procedure, by following the procedure FEEDING THE MEDIA TO CUT, lining up the profile to cut with the LASER beam.
